**Summary of Grants Awarded in 2020-21**

## **Background**

- 1. Berwick Town Council provides grants to various groups to support events, as well as support environmental and community projects.
- Additionally, Berwick Town Council has established a community equipment fund, which is used to purchase equipment that can be loaned to various groups on request.
- 3. The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the grants awarded during the last financial year.

## **Summary of Grants Awarded**

4. Only one grant was awarded during 2020-21, an environmental enhancement grant made to Spittal Improvement Trust.

# Other Regular Financial Support

- 5. Alongside direct grants, Berwick Town Council directly supports the activities of Berwick in Bloom and the Rotary Club, as well as events and Autumn Festivals.
- 6. Due to the cancellation of both the Britain and Northumbria in Bloom events, Berwick in Bloom did not use their budget allocation in 2020-21. Ordinarily, the allocation is used to pay for Northumbria in Bloom entry fees, printing and other costs linked to judging visits and attending award ceremonies.
- 7. Funding for the Rotary Club supports their activities in erecting Christmas Lights on the Royal Tweed Bridge and a Christmas Tree in Marygate. The value of this support was over £2300 in 2020-21.
- 8. Most events in 2020, such as Riding of the Bounds and Tweedmouth Feast, were cancelled. The budget for this area of expenditure is £9250
- 9. The Autumn Festivals, excepting the Food Festival, took place in virtual form and benefitted from Town Council support. In 2020, this support totaled £5277 out of a budget of £10600.
