Access Public

Background

- 1. The Town Council makes grants to independent, self-governing organisations in line with the criteria published on the Town Council's website.
- 2. Applicants complete an application form, also published on the website, and return it to the Town Council office, together with appropriate supporting information detailed in the form.
- 3. On receiving an application, Officers complete a checklist and add the application to the agenda for the next appropriate meeting, normally a meeting of this committee. The application and checklist form part of the meeting papers and except in very rare circumstances, applications are considered in public.
- 4. The Town Council budgets for grants for environmental [£1000] or community projects [£1000].
- 5. Grants are paid to applicants when they provide evidence that they have or will spend the money as described in their application.
- 6. The Town Council also provides regular support to a number of external organisations, such as Berwick in Bloom, Tweedmouth Feast and Autumn Festivals, where the support is administered as grants [evidence of expenditure required]. These are listed in Table 1.
