The identified locations below are all on Northumberland County Council (NCC) property and therefore will require agreement with NCC Green Spaces prior to planting. 4. Committee suggested using Silver Birches to plant as the trees to be lit. 5. This report is intended to establish principal prior to costing.

Tree 1	Adjacent to Spittal War Memorial, left as facing the memorial	What3words: sorry.pies.slower Previous temporary Christmas tree location. Electrical access available.	
Tree 2	Highcliffe, on the left side of Spittal Hall Road	What3words: Monkey.dare.linked New location (ie not a site that Council has previously used for a temporary Christmas tree). Site would afford good view of the tree from the bottom of the hill. Electrical access available.	
Tree 3	Roberts Lodge	What3words: unity.grin.chip New location. Location would act as welcome to travellers on the Etal Road into town. Electrical access available.	
Tree 4	Prior Park	What3words: Boats.wins.admire Previous tree location. Electrical access available.	

Tree 5	Highfields	<p>What3words: Clever.deputy.sounds</p> <p>Previous tree location. Electrical access available.</p> <p>Alternative: instead of planting a tree we could dress existing trees (up to 14 trees) on site to create a high profile Christmas Landmark on the key road into town.</p>	
Tree 6	Tweedmouth	<p>What3words: music.adults.turns</p> <p>Previous Tweedmouth location is not suitable for trees (roundabout at the end of Old Bridge). A suggestion is to move the site to the Queens Gardens</p>
