The retiring Town Mayor, Councillor J Waterhouse, gave an address highlighting the most memorable moments from her term of office.

#### C001/11 1. ELECTION OF TOWN MAYOR

The retiring Town Mayor, Councillor Waterhouse, proposed, and Councillor F Simpson, seconded, the proposition that Councillor Bowlas be elected Town

Mayor of Berwick-upon-Tweed for the year 2011/2012.

RESOLVED: That Councillor Bowlas be appointed Town Mayor of Berwick-upon-Tweed for the year 2010/2011.

The Town Mayor signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office and took the Chair for the remainder of the meeting.

The Town Mayor gave a short address thanking the outgoing Town Mayor and describing the activities which he hoped the Town Council would engage in during the coming year.

#### C002/11 2. ELECTION OF DEPUTY TOWN MAYOR

Councillor Dixon proposed, and Councillor Routledge seconded, the proposition that Councillor Robertson be elected Deputy Town Mayor of Berwick-upon-Tweed for the year 2011/2012, following which a second nomination was received.

Councillor Bettison proposed, and Councillor Pauline seconded, the proposition that Councillor Hunter be elected Deputy Town Mayor for the year 2011/2012.

Each candidate spoke about the contribution which they could make to the role and to the work of the Town Council.

A secret ballot was requested by two members.

The result of the secret ballot was as follows: 9 votes in favour of the election of Councillor Robertson as Deputy Town Mayor for the ensuing year, and 5 in favour of Councillor Hunter.

RESOLVED: That Councillor Robertson be appointed Deputy Town Mayor of Berwick-upon-Tweed for the year 2011-12.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- replacement, if any, for traditional Christmas trees, their views to be considered by the festive lighting working group and the financial implications considered by the Finance and Resources Committee.
- (iii) The Council to discuss with the Freemen's Trust new features for the Town Hall, with a commitment to meet 50% of the costs of what is agreed, subject to a maximum of £4000.
