Report of the Responsible Financial Officer

External Audit

- 1. In common with all other local councils, Berwick Town Council is subject to an annual external audit. The External Auditor is now appointed by Public Sector Audit Appointments Ltd, a function previously undertaken by the Audit Commission. External Auditors are appointed under the provisions of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 on a regional basis to a contract that lasts 5 years.
- 2. The auditors appointed for Northumberland are PKF-Littlejohn, replacing BDO, the previous contract holder. PKF-Littlejohn now hold the contract for 37 areas and will be auditing approximately 8800 local councils around the country, nearly 90% of the total.
- 3. All local councils are required to complete an Annual Governance and Accountability Return [AGAR or Annual Return]. As an active council with income or expenditure above £25000, Berwick Town Council, as in past years, is required to complete AGAR part 3.
- 4. For the year 2017-18, the AGAR part 3 has been slightly redesigned, with some additional information, publication website address and dates of any internal audit visits, being requested. Otherwise, the basic format remains the same.
- 5. Additionally, as a council with income or expenditure over £200000, Berwick Town Council will be subject to an intermediate review, which will request additional information beyond that required by the AGAR part 3.
- 6. In January, the RFO and Finance officer attended a webinar presentation by PKF-Littlejohn that acted as an introduction and update on changes to the process. The presentation slides are available on the PKF-Littlejohn website at http://bit.ly/2EiSfRU.

Recommendation
