


Q1 How often do you visit childrens play areas in Berwick?




Q3 How often do you visit the public parks in Berwick?




Q5 How well are the streets in your part of Berwick maintained?


Q6 How well are the streets in Berwick Town Centre maintained?



Q8 Overall, how clean is your part of Berwick??



Better / more effective planning regulations which give local people more say. Tweedmouth potentially has much to offer but is generally neglected. Given the high quality of local produce, Berwick ought to have a farmers' market. Out of town supermarkets are more than enough. Charity and bargain shops are too many. Berwick is by the coast yet has no fishmonger. We have an excess of large pet food retailers, and the recent arrival of Pets at Home is a shocking example of bad planning. Time, energy and money have rightly been spent on children's play areas but it seems at the expense of other improvements. The Neighbourhood Plan ought to protect the Town Green at Tweedmouth and the Goodie Patchie. Out-of-town parking ought to be high on the agenda so as to reduce congestion and limit the number of vehicles in the town centre. I regularly sweep up leaves outside my house, taking sack-fulls to the recycling depot: this is never done (properly) by council workers. Street cleaning is poor generally. Advance notice needs to be provided re street cleaning vehicles so that cars can be moved and parked elsewhere. A local train service to Edinburgh / Newcastle would be a major improvement: at the moment it's impossible to have a night out in either of those places because main line trains don't run late enough. Hide Hill and Bridge St are currently the most attractive streets in Berwick town centre: the Town Council need to do more to ensure these streets retain their special character including careful consideration of the type of shop / business allowed. The Town Council's website is rudimentary at best, unattractive, not user-friendly, and gives a negative impression to outsiders. There appears to be no process for contacting town counsellors in person. While recent improvements in the modus operandi of council meetings are significant there remains a lack of effective participation from the public: council meetings are not sufficiently welcoming. The layout of the room is itself unhelpful: often difficult to hear what's being said, and individual Counsellors are not always mindful of the need to speak clearly. The Mayor gives an impression of having to race through the agenda. This year's Town Meeting was a disgrace: no Mayor, no apology, whoever it was that stood in did not introduce himself, and the meeting was kicked off by a squabble among Councillors about a matter that ought to have settled outside the meeting. Given the size of the room, there surely ought to be a sound system. The guest speakers were good (albeit one said he was himself surprised to have been invited 2 years in a row), but there was a total absence of Town Council input: what indeed had they been doing in the previous year? We never did find out. In Berwick overall there seems no shortage of voluntary groups and volunteers, which is great and surely a huge asset, but perhaps a failure of co-ordination? Too many groups with fingers in particular pies?
