## Background

1. At the last meeting of the Local Service Committee Councillors asked officers to consider options for fencing the allotments at Five Arches.

## Issues

1. Officers anticipate the cost of railings as opposed to fencing will be greater than the budget will allow, so any proposal will require a decision from Council to fund it from reserves.
2. Below is an example of fencing along with a quote.
1.8m High 'V' Mesh Security Fencing


Length of fence required = 124.4 metres approximately
$£ 47.15$ per 3 metre panel $=£ 1980.30$ exc VAT
4 corner posts (at $£ 35.00$ exc VAT) $=£ 140.00$ exc VAT
1 torque kit = £2.50 exc VAT

An example of a gate is also included below:
Twin Mesh Single Leaf Gate -1.8 m high $\times 2.0 \mathrm{~m}$ wide

£429.00 exc VAT
