- Five Arches Park to take forward enhancement proposals for the site working with the Friends Group and football club to develop funding sources.
- Goodie Patchy / Town Green Dock Road working alongside the St Boisels Residents Group on habitat improvements and potential Forest Schools. Also working with the new litter picking group on tidy ups.
- Flagstaff Park to develop the area to improve the rose garden by enhancing the existing planting schemes, and working with NEAT, BTC, volunteer gardeners etc.
- Spittal organise beach clean ups, working with Spittal Improvement Trust and associated gardening volunteer group to develop Seafield Park / High Street planting beds.
- Further develop the Friends Group in Castle Vale & Coronation Parks to continue
  the events programme, achieve Green Flag success and to participate in the In
  Bloom bid. Work with Norstar and community reparation on practical maintenance
  works and set up a hot spot gardening volunteer group to target problem areas in the
  town's estates.
- Bankside work with BTC / HE / NCC NEAT on this potential development.
- The Haugh work with Berwick Wildlife group on further site improvements.
- Horticultural advice to In Bloom. Continuing with the Open gardens scheme and expanding to other areas of the town. Planting schemes and high profile visitor welcome areas eg Spittal Promenade, entrance to Haven Holiday Camp.
