Directory of Voluntary Groups in Berwick-upon-Tweed

Background

- Council needs, on occasions, to consult the local voluntary and community sector (VCS)
 to inform the development of policy. A good example is the issue of the provision of
 advice services; another is the issue of hard to reach groups.
- 2. The VCS infrastructure organizations operating in the town are still configured around the former borough council boundaries that ceased to exist in 2009.
- It would be helpful if council could develop a directory of VCS organizations that either operate in Berwick, or which specifically offer services to residents of Berwick. The timing is appropriate since such a directory would also be a useful addition to the new council website.

Issues

- 1. Does the committee consider a Berwick specific directory would be useful to residents of the town?
- 2. Does the committee endorse the proposal that such a directory should be hosted on the council website?
