Notes on the Completion of Claim Forms

When completing the claim form, applicants should state:-

1. Full name, permanent address and description of occupation.

E.g. James Robert Brown of 125 Conquest Road, Harpenden, Hertfordshire; Civil Servant.

2. Date of Birth.

A Certified Copy of an Entry of Birth in the full form (showing parentage) accompanied by parents' Marriage Certificate must be forwarded with the claim. They will be returned after the ceremony. Photocopies or other reproductions are not acceptable.

3. The title upon which the claim to be admitted is made.

If an only, please say so. If not, put one of the following: Eldest* or elder+, second, third etc., youngest* or younger+.

*Appropriate if more than two children. +Appropriate if only two children.

4. Full name of father/mother and the date of his/her admission to the Freedom.

If father/mother is now deceased, please indicate this on the claim form, by adding "deceased".

The fees on admission amount to £25.00. This amount must accompany claim forms. Cheques or Postal Orders should be made payable to "Berwick-upon-Tweed Town Council".

Claims should be dated and signed by the applicant and forwarded to the Town Clerk, Berwick-upon-Tweed Town Council, Berwick Workspace, Boarding School Yard, 90 Marygate, Berwick-upon-Tweed, Northumberland. TD15 1BN; with an indication of the date upon which it is desired to be admitted. (See the provisions of the accompanying notice).
